Earlier this year **Selasee** has taken 1st place in the World music category and 2nd place for the "People's choice" award at the *2005 International Songwriting Competition (ISC)* for his song "Run". The ISC has been described by the New York Times as "the songwriting contest to take note of". The winners are chosen from 15,000 entries coming from 80 different countries.

The song "Run" also got an honorable mention at the Billboard World songwriting competition.
